Srishti - Nina Rajarani Dance School has been flourishing at the Harrow Arts Centre in Hatch End, Middlesex since 1991. Over the years, Nina Rajarani MBE has earned herself an admirable reputation as a teacher, and her students pride themselves upon their high standard of dancing. The school emphasises a strong, classical training firmly rooted in Bharatanatyam tradition.

Bharatanatyam is a classical dance style originating in the temples of Southern India. Characterised by its strong lines, geometry and symmetry, as well as its highly expressive mime, it is probably the most popular Indian classical dance style worldwide.

We offer:

- ♦ **Foundation Year:** an introduction to Bharatanatyam for beginner-level children. Students must be at least 5 years old on the 1st of September in the academic year in which they join the school.
- ♦ **Graded Examination Course:** for students who have completed at least our Foundation Year. Entry can also be at a higher level as it is not necessary to start from Grade One. Examinations are conducted by the ISTD (Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing), the world's leading dance examinations board.
- ♦ **Advanced Training:** for those who have had several years of Bharatanatyam training either with or without examinations, with the opportunity to join our youth group, Srishti Yuva Culture, for those of age 16 and above. Performance experience is the focus of this group.
- ♦ **Adult Classes:** for recreational dancers, with or without prior experience.
- ♦ **1-to-1 Sessions:** for both adults and children who cannot join regular group classes, who require training in order to enter a particular grade level, or who would like to have a tailor-made class.
