A creative project for young people using South Asian dance and music to discuss and challenge stereotypes about gangs

LOOK SHARP is a new creative project led by Srishti Skills in partnership with Harrow Youth Crime Prevention Team and the Metropolitan Police, aimed at providing information and a supportive environment in which to discuss the sensitive issues of gangs and knife crime.

Over 10 sessions, groups of young people will learn the basic skills of South Asian dance and music, and use these art forms as communication tools to create scenarios to discuss, alter and challenge stereotypes around gangs.

The project aims to create debate without argument, and to steer young people into their own self-discovery.

At the end of the 10 sessions the groups will create their own piece of work using these scenarios as inspiration and will present this work to one another and to friends and families.
